

She got injured and it caused sleeping spells when she was bired by heighborshop. After that, she learned about secret communication from free black people by working with her father. She married and change her name to Harriet. When her owner died, she decided to be free. She helped her family and others by traveling 13 times to south. She worked hard and she became a first woman to lead military to make 700 slaves in South Carolina free. After that, government decide to abolish slaving. She fought for women's voting rights and try to increase the fund and help black people to have
